The goal of the Weldon STEM High School Career Academies (WSHSCA) admissions process is to select and admit a diverse group of students who have a genuine interest in the pursuit of this unique and rigorous program. The selected student population will closely reflect the diversity of Halifax County, including academic, ethnic, geographic, and socioeconomic diversity. Before completing the application, please review the information below. If you have any questions, please see your middle school counselor before completing the application.

Is Weldon STEM High School Career Academies the right place for you?

- WSHSCA is a four year program and requires a four-year commitment.
- Students complete a high school diploma, college certificates, and up to two-years of college transfer credit.
- Students often work in teams on projects and presentations.
- Learning is assessed nontraditionally as well as by standardized testing.
- Students will participate in many off-campus learning activities; participation is required.
- College classes for WSHSCA students require the same expectations, content, and levels of rigor as for traditional college students.
- College classes have no excused absences. Once absences exceed the maximum number, students are dropped from college courses.
- Cost of college textbooks is covered by Weldon City Schools (WCS).
- Students are eligible to participate in WCS district high school athletic programs, band, chorus, and JROTC programs.
- Bus transportation is provided from specified locations around the Weldon City Schools districts perimeter or from the student's home if you live within the Weldon City Schools district lines. If you live outside of the Weldon City School's district lines, you will be expected to arrange transportation to and from WSHSCA or to and from the transportation pick-up/drop off locations designated by Weldon City Schools.

Parent/Legal Guardian Commitment

The parent's/legal guardian's and family's commitment to the Career Academies concept is essential. These expectations include but are not limited to the following:

- monthly PTA meetings,
- parent teacher student conferences,
- written communication through report cards, progress reports, and

 - State Testing Summary for the student (include all EOG scores for both elementary and middle school years)
 - Final report card from 2 previous school years and the student's most recent report card for current school year
 - One copy of the student's birth certificate and social security card (SS card needs to be signed)

- **Recommendations are required from each of the following individuals. The recommendation form is provided in Part D of this application.**
 - Core Teacher
 - Other school staff such as, school counselor, elective teacher, teacher assistant, administrator, etc.
 - Community Person (Recommendations from relatives are not acceptable)

- **In order to participate in the Interview you must have a completed application turned in before the application deadline. Students selected for interviews will be notified of the interview date, time, and location.**
- **Parents of students selected for interviews will be interviewed at the same time as the student.**
